- I will not use iPads or other technology in school without permission from my teacher.
- I will not tell anyone my password or ask computers to remember my password.
- I must keep my personal details and those of others private.
- I know that not everyone is who they say they are on the internet so when I am on the internet I will not tell anyone information about myself.
- I will 'think before I click.'
- I will make good choices about the websites I use and how long to stay online.
- I will not visit unsafe sites or register for things I am not old enough for.
- When I see something unexpected or worrying online, I will use Hector to cover the screen and tell an adult straight away.
- I will log off sites when I have finished.
- I know that I need to behave well online as in real life and be polite and friendly.
- I will not take pictures of myself or anyone else and share them online.
- I know that others may have different opinions and that I should respect them.
- I know that I must have permission to communicate online and will make sure my teacher / parents know who I communicate with.
- I will not damage equipment and will tell an adult if the equipment is broken or not working.
- I will not change computer settings on purpose.
- I know that I should not buy anything on line without permission.
- I will remember that not all information on the internet is true.
- I know I have to be sensible, both in and out of school.
- If I break the rules I know that I might not be allowed to use the school resources.
