Triple P are offering Discussion Groups over the summer for families. Please contact Mrs Jones if you would like to attend. You can attend the Discussion Group you feel meets your needs



Spring has arrived in the Nursery. The children have looked at the shapes and colours of daffodils and painted pictures of them. In Owls we have been learning about a Rags to Riches story 'The Magic Porridge Pot' and had a go at writing our very own! One of our favourites was The Magic Popcorn Pot which wouldn't stop popping!
In DT we have been learning about where food comes from and healthy eating. We are going to be designing and making our own healthy snack bars in the next few weeks.

This term, in History, Rabbits have been learning about changes within living memory. They have been focusing on how the toys that we play with have changed over the last 50 years and they have written some questions to ask a visitor who has played with different toys to what they will have played with.

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In Badgers we have been enjoying learning about wishing stories, and retelling the story of Chang and his magic paintbrush. The children have had some brilliant ideas for their own wishing stories, and are enjoying writing them this



In Squirrels, we are enjoying our Creative cog in our PE lessons. This means that we have been practicing close control of balls both on our own and with our partners. We decided that some of the skills that we are learning would help us if we wanted to play basketball!

We are thoroughly enjoying our Science unit on 'microhabitats' and cannot wait to visit the Glebe on Tuesday to see what minibeasts we can spot in their micro habitats.
