The Nursery Team are so happy to welcome back our children who were with us last year and to say hello to all of our new children. Everyone has settled in so well. The children have been exploring all of the indoor and outdoor areas as well as making new friends.







This week Foxcubs have started to learn the story 'The Little Red Hen'. We found footprints of flour in the outdoor classroom and found the little red hen at the end! We have been learning the story by using actions to help us. We are going to be making bread this week just like her!
